NEED	APPROXIMATE GOAL	WHY IT MATTERS
EKG MACHINE	\$2,500 – \$4,000	Evaluates cardiac symptoms and supports safer assessment for patients with chronic conditions.
RETINAL SCANNER	\$5,000 – \$10,000	Enables early detection and referral for diabetes-related eye disease and other retinal concerns.
BLOOD-WORK FUND	\$5,000 INITIAL GOAL	Covers essential lab tests to screen and monitor diabetes, kidney disease, cholesterol, anemia, and more.
MEDICATION ASSISTANCE	\$5,000 INITIAL GOAL	Helps patients get prescribed medications when cost would otherwise prevent treatment.
CWH CARES COPAYMENT ASSISTANCE	\$30 PER PATIENT	Helps patients access care when even modest copayment is a barrier.
